All streamed and on-demand CPE activities will be home-study CPE format, will be released September 18, and can be viewed in the OPA Independent Pharmacy Expo virtual platform (*LecturePanda*). All CPE activities will be available in the platform until November 18, 2022.

Slide the button to the right for *Remember Me on This Device* to make sign-in automatic for the next CPE activity to be claimed during this event.

You will receive a confirmation message from LecturePanda after your first sign-in. This message will give you a link directly to LecturePanda. You will also receive reminder notifications from LecturePanda to complete your credits until you have submitted credit for your sessions or until November 18, 2022.
